Fee Standards for the Use of Computer Classrooms at the Computer
Center

Article 1

These Fee Standards are established in accordance with the 'National Taiwan University of Science and Technology Regulations Governing the Management of Self-Raised Revenues under the University Endowment Fund' for the purpose of administering charges for the use of the Computer Center's computer classrooms under the University Endowment Fund.

Article 2

To support the University's teaching, research, and administrative informatization, the following preferential rates apply:

1. Official semester courses offered by the University: Free of charge.
2. Official administrative activities organized for University faculty, staff, and students: Free of charge.
3. Academic activities organized by University administrative or academic units: 50% of the standard fee.
4. Computer-related training courses organized by University clubs for University faculty, staff, students, or their dependents: 25% of the standard fee.
5. All other uses: Full standard fee applies.
6. Fees may be waived upon special approval for public-interest or other special circumstances. This provision does not apply if participation fees are collected.

Article 3

Computer classrooms available for rental and the applicable fees are as follows:

1. Classroom rental fee: NT\$12,000 per classroom per session; maintenance and administration fee: NT\$3,500 per use.
2. One billing session consists of three (3) hours. Usage of less than three hours shall still be charged as one full session.
3. If legally licensed user-provided software must be installed, an additional NT\$2,000 shall be charged for each software package installed.
4. Users eligible under Article 2, Subparagraphs 1, 2, or 6 are exempt from the maintenance and administration fee.

Article 4

These Fee Standards shall take effect upon approval by the University's Administrative Meeting. The same procedure shall apply to any amendments.
